HOW TO: USE TENDTO'S TEXT BANKING

Text Banking is the easiest way to access your Tendto accounts. Whether you have a smartphone or not, you will have access to your accounts in an instant.

To get access to Tendto's Text Banking, you must have your phone set up for Mobile Alerts - even if you do not receive Mobile Alerts. You can set up your phone for Mobile Alerts through Online Banking in the Self Service tab, Mobile Banking or by speaking to a Tendto team member.

To begin using Text Banking, simply text MENU to our 5 digit code - 61802. Make sure to save the code as a contact for future reference.



- 1. When you opt-in to the service, we will send you an SMS message to confirm your signup.
- 2. You can cancel the SMS service at any time. Just text "OPTOUT" to 61802. After you send the SMS message "OPTOUT" to us, we will send you an SMS message to confirm that you have been unsubscribed. After this, you will no longer receive SMS messages from us. If you want to join again, just sign up as you did the first time and we will start sending SMS messages to you again.
- 3. If at any time you forget what keywords are supported, just text "MENU" to 6.
- 4. After you send the SMS message "**MENU**" to us, we will respond with instructions on how to use our service as well as how to unsubscribe.
- 5. We are able to deliver messages to the following mobile phone carriers:

The Tendto Credit Union ("Tendto") Text Banking and Text Messaging application ("Tendto Text Banking") and the associated Tendto Credit Union Online Banking site available at tendtocu.com are owned and operated Tendto Credit Union ("us" "we" or "our"). This Tendto Text Banking & Text Messaging Privacy Statement (the "Privacy Statement") is intended to inform you of our policies and practices regarding the collection, use and disclosure of any information you submit to us through Tendto Text Banking. This includes "Personal Information," which is information about you that is personally identifiable such as your name, e-mail address, user ID number, and other non-public information that is associated with the foregoing, as well as "Anonymous Information," which is information that is not associated with or linked to your Personal Information and does not permit the identification of individual persons.

USER CONSENT

By accessing or otherwise using Tendto Text Banking, you agree to the terms and conditions of this Privacy Statement and the associated Text Banking and Text Messaging Short Code Terms of Service found at tendtocu.com. You expressly consent to the processing of your Personal Information and Anonymous Information according to this Privacy Statement. Your Personal Information may be processed by us in the country where it was collected as well as other countries (including the United States) where laws regarding processing of personal Information may be less stringent than the laws in your country.

REGARDING CHILDREN

Children under the age of 13 are not permitted to use Tendto Text Banking and we do not intentionally collect or maintain Personal Information from those who are under 13 years old. Protecting the privacy of children is very important to us. Thus, if we obtain actual knowledge that a user is under 13, we will take steps to remove that user's Personal Information from our databases. We recommend that children between the ages of 13 and 18 obtain their parent's permission before submitting information over the internet. By using Tendto Text Banking, you are representing that you are at least 18 years old or that you are at least 13 years old and have your parents' permission to use Tendto Text Banking.

COLLECTION AND USE OF PERSONAL INFORMATION

In general, we collect Personal Information that you submit to us voluntarily through Tendto Text Banking. We also collect information that you submit in the process of creating or editing your account and user profile on Tendto Text Banking. For example, our registration and login process requires you to provide us with your name, valid email address and password of your choice. When you personalize your profile and use the features of Tendto Text Banking, we will collect any information you voluntarily provide, and we may also request optional information to support your use of Tendto Text Banking, such as your year of birth, gender and other demographic information. We collect information in the form of the content that you submit during your use of Tendto Text Banking, such as photos, comments, ratings and other information you choose to submit.

PERSONAL INFORMATION FROM OTHER SOURCES

We may receive Personal Information about you from other sources with which you have registered, companies who we have partnered with (collectively, "Partners") or other third parties. We may associate this information with the other Personal Information we have collected about you.

INFORMATION COLLECTED VIA TECHNOLOGY

As you use Tendto Text Banking, certain information may also be passively collected and stored on our or our service providers' server logs, including your Internet protocol address, browser type, and operating system. We also use Cookies and navigational data like Uniform Resource Locators (URL) to gather information regarding the date and time of your visit and the solutions and information for which you searched and viewed, or on which of the advertisements displayed on Tendto Text Banking you clicked. This type of information is collected to make Tendto Text Banking and solutions more useful to you and to tailor the experience with Tendto Text Banking to meet your special interests and needs.

An "Internet protocol address" or "IP Address" is a number that is automatically assigned to your computer when you use the Internet. In some cases your IP Address stays the same from browser session to browser session; but if you use a



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consumer internet access provider, your IP Address probably varies from session to session. For example, we, or our service providers, may track your IP Address when you access Tendto Text Banking to assist with ad targeting.

"Cookies" are small pieces of information that a website sends to your computer's hard drive while you are viewing a website. We may use both session Cookies (which expire once you close your web browser) and persistent Cookies (which stay on your computer until you delete them) to provide you with a more personal and interactive experience with Tendto Text Banking. Persistent Cookies can be removed by following your Internet browser help file directions. In order to use our services offered through Tendto Text Banking, your web browser must accept Cookies. If you choose to disable Cookies, some aspects of Tendto Text Banking may not work properly, and you will not be able to receive our services.

USE AND DISCLOSURE OF INFORMATION

Except as otherwise stated in this Privacy Statement, we do not generally sell, trade, rent, or share the Personal Information that we collect with third parties, unless you ask or authorize us to do so.

We may provide your Personal Information to third-party service providers who work on behalf of or with us to provide some of the services and features of Tendto's Text Banking and to help us communicate with you. Examples of such services include sending email, analyzing data, providing marketing assistance, processing payments (including credit card payments), and providing customer service. We require our third-party service providers to promise not to use such information except as necessary to provide the relevant services to us. We may share some or all of your Personal Information with our third-party partners, those with whom we have a co-branding or promotional relationship, or other third-parties about whom you are otherwise notified and do not request to opt out of such sharing. This Privacy Statement does not cover the use of your personally identifiable information by such third-parties. We do not maintain responsibility for the manner in which third parties, including, without limitation, social networks, other partners and advertisers, use or further disclose Personal Information collected from you in accordance with this Privacy Statement, after we have disclosed such information to those third parties. If you do not want us to use or disclose Personal Information collected about you in the manners identified in this Privacy Statement, you may not use Tendto Text Banking.

Although we currently do not have a parent company, any subsidiaries, joint ventures, or other companies under a common control, we may in the future, and we may share some or all of your Personal Information with these companies, in which case we will require them to honor this Privacy Statement.

In the event we go through a business transition such as a merger, acquisition by another company, or sale of all or a portion of its assets, your Personal Information may be among the assets transferred. You acknowledge that such transfers may occur and are permitted by this Privacy Statement, and that any acquirer of ours or that acquirer's assets may continue to process your Personal Information as set forth in this Privacy Statement. We may disclose your Personal Information if we believe in good faith that such disclosure is necessary to (a) comply with relevant laws or to respond to subpoenas or warrants served on us; or (b) to protect and defend our rights or property, you, or third parties. You hereby consent to us sharing your Personal Information under the circumstances described herein.

THE ABILITY OF OTHERS TO VIEW YOUR INFORMATION

Helping you to protect your information is a vital part of our mission. It is up to you to make sure you are comfortable with the information you choose to provide us and the information you choose to publish. We will not have any obligations with respect to any information that you post to parts of Tendto Text Banking available to others, and recommend that you use caution when giving out personal information to others in public forums online or otherwise. We also share the information you publish with other third parties.

THIRD PARTY SITES AND ADVERTISING

Tendto Text Banking may contain links to other websites. Please be aware that we are not responsible for the privacy practices or the content of such other websites. We encourage our users to read the privacy statements of each and every website they visit. This Tendto Text Banking Privacy Statement applies solely to information collected by us through Tendto Text Banking and does not apply to these third-party websites. The ability to access information of third parties from Tendto Text Banking, or links to other websites or locations, is for your convenience and does not signify our endorsement of such third-parties, their products, their services, other websites, locations or their content.



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YOUR CHOICES REGARDING YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION

We offer you choices regarding the collection, use, and sharing of your Personal Information. When you receive promotional communications from us, you may indicate a preference to stop receiving further promotional communications from us and you will have the opportunity to "opt-out" by following the unsubscribe instructions provided in the promotional e-mail you receive or by contacting us directly (please see contact information below).

We will collect any information contained in such feedback and will treat the Personal Information in it in accordance with this Privacy Statement.
